The El Paso and Teller County Enhanced 9-1-1 Authority Board shall be responsible for the continuous and day-to-day maintenance of the Enhanced 9-1-1 System, associated equipment is defined as:

1. ANI-ALI Equipment
2. Telephone Equipment
3. Computer Equipment
4. Generators
5. Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS)
6. Any other equipment/items authorized and purchased by the Enhanced 9-1-1 Authority Board

These agencies, as system participants, shall operate and maintain the PSAP Enhanced 9-1-1 equipment and associated systems and equipment provided to them, in accordance with Board approved policies and procedures.

The Authority Board's operating structure is set forth in the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) and By-laws as established by the Board. By-laws can be updated regularly at the discretion of the Board.
