



Resolution 24-05

Authority Member Graham moved approval of the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING COLORADO SB 24-052, ONGOING FUNDING FOR THE 911 RESOURCE CENTER.

WHEREAS, SB24-052 was submitted to the Colorado General Assembly on January 17, 2024; and an amendment was adopted to this bill on January 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, The amendment added to this bill requires the Colorado Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") to promulgate rules establishing "voluntary" standards for public safety answering points ("PSAPs"); and

WHEREAS, The standards for PSAPs would require, at a minimum, training standards, equipment standards, service level standards, and operational standards; and

WHEREAS, The standards envisioned by this bill would duplicate requirements already implemented by the El Paso Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority ("Authority") and PSAPs providing service to citizens within the Authority's service area in El Paso and Teller Counties; and

WHEREAS, the PUC does not have the expertise necessary to adopt the standards proposed in this bill; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

On behalf of the citizens served by the Authority, the Board of Directors of the Authority hereby adopts this Resolution in opposition to SB24-052 and urges the members of the Colorado Legislature not to pass this legislation.

Authority Member Wolff seconded the adoption of the foregoing resolution. The roll having been called; the vote was as follows:


